



4th Grade Supply List

Please have your student bring the following items:

- *A pencil pouch or box (The depth of the cubbies is 1 1/2 inches. It must fit inside the cubby.)
- 40 pencils (half sharpened) and a good pencil sharpener that catches the shavings (collected)
- 12 pencil top erasers (collected)
- 5 red grading pencils or pens (collected)
- 2 fine-tip black Sharpies (collected)
- 4 hi-lighters (collected)
- 1 package of black dry erase markers (at least 10) (collected)
- *1 whiteboard eraser
- *1 box of markers, one box of crayons, one box of colored pencils (Yes, you will need all three!)
- *4 – double pocket folders (design and color of your choice)
- 1 package of notebook paper (wide-ruled, loose leaf) (collected)
- 3 inch square post-it notes (3 pads) (collected)
- 2 -100 sheet Composition Books (9³/₄ x 7¹/₂)
- 3 **BIG** glue sticks (collected)
- *1 pair of scissors
- *1 basic four-function calculator
- *1 NIV Bible
- *Webster's New World Dictionary or Scholastic Children's Dictionary.
- *1 Thesaurus
- 1 package of baby wipes **and** one 3-pack container of Clorox Wipes
- *1 pair of wired headphones for use with Chromebooks and iPads (these last longer than earbuds)
- *1 wired mouse for use with Chromebooks
- A **MEDIUM-SIZED** backpack (No wheels!)

All items with an **asterisk (*)** need to be labeled with the student's name. I encourage you to pack these items in a large recyclable bag instead of jamming it all in their backpack. It makes it easier to find it all! Please remember the chapter books your student needs too:
